In celebration of 50 years of community councils and the hard work of the legacy of volunteers, the FCC is recognizing those who drive civic engagement in our neighborhoods.

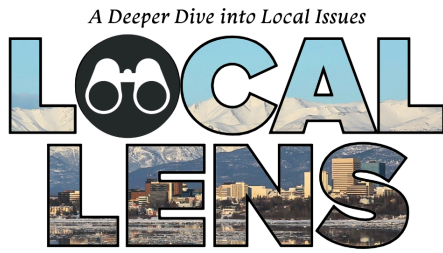
